

TV Star Nabbed For Firing Blank

NEW YORK (AP)—A pistol shot shattered the Sabbath quiet of Manhattan Sunday and police rounded up Bob Fuller, star of the TV Western "Laramie," wearing full cowboy regalia and accompanied by two models.

Fuller said his holstered revolver, loaded with blanks, discharged accidentally as he entered a taxicab. He was paroled for a hearing Nov. 25 on a charge of discharging a gun in a public place.

He said he was wearing the cowboy duds for an appearance on a TV show.
